To the parents and students of the Lycée Français International de Bangkok

Madam, Sir,

The administrative authorities, which had decided to introduce distance education from 4 January, have not yet decided to extend this measure. In this context, we are preparing to be able to welcome students again for face-to-face classes for all levels from Monday 1st February. All facilities and services will be operational from the first day.

This latest period of distance learning has shown us some fragilities in keeping the balances and that the switch to distance learning can occur anytime if the health situation was to deteriorate promptly.

In this context, we invite all the families to be particularly vigilant about their children's health and, at the slightest symptom, not to send their children to school. Families who have travelled to one of the risk zones between January 15th and 31st will kindly inform us and observe a period of self-quarantine at home. At the school entrance, we will continue to apply our sanitary protocol: temperature verifying, hand washing and mask.

Finally, for this short two-week period of classes before the holidays, we ask all students to bring to class only things necessary for the day's work. In any case, all classroom items must be taken home for the February holidays, and the lockers at the secondary school must be emptied on the last day of class. The digital material that has been lent to the families can be kept until the return from the February holidays.

The meeting planned for the parents of year 2nde students on February 4th is maintained via Zoom (Choices of speciality courses).

A new date will be set for the conference on risky behaviours as soon as we can organise it in the presence of the speakers and parents.

The "Open House" morning is maintained on Friday 5 February via Zoom. Personalised visits of the school will then be proposed.

We are of course subject to the decisions of the Thai authorities. If there was an instruction to extend distance learning or to resume it gradually within a week, I would inform you as soon as possible.

On behalf of the management team, I would like to thank you for your engagement and trust you have shown regarding the school and its administrative, pedagogical and Vie Scolaire teams.
