To the parents and students of the Lycée Français International de Bangkok

Madam, Sir,

The Bangkok municipality announced on Sunday 18 April that schools would be closed until further notice.

Classes will resume on Monday 26 April with Distance Learning:

- In kindergarten and primary school, according to the instructions of your child's class teacher
- In secondary school, according to the instructions specified by teachers in Pronote

Please find attached our two reference documents:

- Charter of good conduct during video conference session
- The guide to organising distance learning in continuity in secondary school

A specific message will be sent to new families whose children will start at the LFIB on 26 April and who may not be familiar with our Distance Learning tools.

I would also like to provide you with some additional information:

- 1) All classes are maintained in distance learning mode, including all activities proposed by all non-teaching specialists: teachers of French as a foreign language (FLE), speech therapists and school psychologists.
- 2) All planned educational trips and sports competitions are cancelled.
- 3) All Extra School Activities (AES) not taking place from 26 April onwards will be refunded at the end of the school year.
- 4) Concerning already paid school catering, a pro rata reimbursement according to the number of days without service will be made at the end of the school year.
- 5) Blue Jade will communicate directly with users of the school transport service.
- 6) Any families who need to borrow computer equipment from the LFIB can send their request directly to the IT department by email: [sysadmin@lfib.ac.th](mailto:sysadmin@lfib.ac.th) They can be picked up from Wednesday 21 April onwards.
- 7) The secondary school CDI will organise a book lending system with online reservation and deposit for collection at the entrance of the school. The students will be informed next week by a specific email from the librarian, Mr. GUILLEROT.
- 8) The dialogue with the parents' representatives continues on a regular basis: the next meeting with the parents elected to the Conseil d'Établissement is scheduled on Friday 30 April at 10.00 a.m. Please do not hesitate to send your comments or questions to [conseil.etablissement.parents@lfib.ac.th](mailto:conseil.etablissement.parents@lfib.ac.th)

- 9) The Thai authorities require that the school be informed of any confirmed Covid-19 positive cases among its students and staff. Information should be sent to [secretariat.direction@lfb.ac.th](mailto:secretariat.direction@lfb.ac.th)
