### **Parent-teacher meetings in kindergarten**

Following the transmission of the learning progress log books in kindergarten, we will organise individual meetings at the school (no meeting via Zoom) with the teachers of your children (class teacher, language teachers, and FLE teacher from PS to GS).

*NB: For pupils in GS, the "carnet de suivi" will be presented to you during this meeting.*

These meetings are offered from Wednesday 18th January to Friday 27th January included, depending on the availability of the teachers concerned. Each meeting lasts 20 minutes for the class teacher and 10 minutes for the language teachers.

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### AES

The next session of the AES will start on 27th February.  
Here is the registration calendar:

It becomes tricky to manage groups when you cancel a registration after confirmation. ### Social media

We would like to draw your attention to the use of social media by children. Incidents between students related to social media are on an increasing trend. The possibility for children under 13 to use social media is not recommended, or even strongly discouraged. In the private sphere, adult supervision is very important and adults can be held criminally liable.

At school, in the school curriculum, there are various educational sessions to raise awareness of the advantages but also the dangers of using the internet in general and the use of communication tools (blogs, messaging, image rights, etc.).
