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Welcoming new French-speaking pupils

In partnership with Alliance Française de Bangkok, LFIB organised and hosted the 1st integration camp for new French-speaking students from 28 August to 1 September. 20 students (10 maternelle and 10 elementary) attended classes and activities in French, at school, to prepare for the start of the new school year. This integration continues with the creation of the FLSco+ classes, providing intensive French classes every morning for the school's neo-French-speaking pupils.



French classes at LFIB, in partnership with the Alliance Française de Bangkok, will be offered to non-French-speaking parents at the end of September. We will keep you informed.

Language classes (Thai and English) will start on Thursday 7th September to allow teachers to assess new pupils individually. Please note that the afternoon Thai lessons will start on Monday 4th September.

Individualised Care Protocol

If your child suffers from a food or other allergy, we invite you to contact the school to set up an Individualised Care Plan so that we can make the necessary arrangements (meals, exemption, etc.), have an emergency medicine kit at school and intervene in the event of an incident.

If you are collecting your child from school, we would remind you that the leaving times are 2.10pm, 3.10pm or 4.10pm, depending on the activities chosen. It is essential that you collect your child on time.
