Ambassadeurs Ambassadrices en Herbe

This year, the Lycée Français International de Bangkok is taking part in the Ambassadeurs Ambassadrices en Herbe project, a pilot educational action managed by the AEFE.

From primary school through to high school, this project uses multilingual skills to explore current international issues across a range of subjects. Developed around real "oratory tournaments", the project is strongly focused on diversified oral practices.

This year, the question put to the students is: "1924-2024: the Olympic and Paralympic Games, a unifying, inclusive and sustainable event? "

15 pupils from CM1 and CM2, 2 from Collège and 3 from Lycée will take part in the school final on Tuesday 6th February. The pupils selected will represent the LFIB at the Asia-Pacific final from 31st March to 3rd April in Phnom Penh.
