Language lessons cancelled on 08/03

Professional training is scheduled for all primary school language teaching staff on Friday 8th March 2024. Consequently, language lessons are cancelled on that day. Pupils will remain with the class teacher if a language lesson is scheduled for the day.

Reinforced Thai classes for CP and CE1, from 14:10 to 15:10, are also cancelled. A specific email was sent to the parents concerned before the holidays.

<u>Re-enrolment for the start of the school year 2024</u>

This year, students can re-register directly on Eduka until 11th March. In order to prepare for the start of the new school year, it is important to have a clear picture of the number of pupils reenrolled as soon as possible. We therefore invite parents who are certain that their child will be attending LFIB in September 2024 to re-register their child as soon as the service opens.

If you are unsure, you can contact the headteacher to inform him of the possibility of your child leaving the school.

Finally, if you know that you will be leaving the school at the end of the school year, you can start the leaving process via Eduka.

Parent-teacher meetings

The second parent-teacher meetings for classes from CP to CM2 in the 2023-2024 school year will be held from Monday 8th to Thursday 11th April inclusive, depending on the availability of the teachers (class teacher, English teacher, reinforced Thai teacher, FLE teacher).
